ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All Players:

- Must have played in a league session (January 1st, 2024-December 31st, 2024) annual fees of \$15 to Western BCA and \$20 to CSI/BCAPL (through your League Operator) and must have played at least 8 calendar weeks in a single division in a regularly scheduled league session between January 1st, 2024, and December 31st, 2024. Players who did not qualify in 2024 but played 8 weeks in a single division in a league session in 2025 and paid the \$15 and \$20 annual fees in 2025 by September 1st, 2025.
- Must be players in good standing with Western BCA and the Chinook Winds Casino Resort.
- Must provide a valid Social Security Number or International ID number to Payouts before receiving any prize money.

TO SIGN UP – Go to <u>www.westernbca.org</u> to sign up for events. **EARLY ENTRIES** accepted until **September 7**th at 11:59 PM 2025. **LATE ENTRIES will start September 8**th at 12:00 AM 2025 and ALL entries will stop September 19th, 2025, at 11:59 PM. **LATE FEES** will be as follows and will be per entry: Singles \$25.00, Scotch \$25.00, and Teams \$45.00.

ESTIMATED START TIMES BY DIVISION

These Estimated Start Dates are based on last event's division brackets and may change depending on any division's entry totals. Online brackets will again be used and will be available as soon as the entries are in and verified. There will be no paper brackets at this event. All times and matches are subject to change without notice and it is the players responsibility to know their own match time. REFUNDS: Use NFR Forms up to September 19th, 2025. Written request must be made September 20th – 26th, 2025. No refunds after September 15th, 2025. Processing refunds may be delayed until after the 9-Ball Championships are over.

SCOTCH DOUBLES, MIXED SCOTCH DOUBLES AND TEAM FORMATS:

ALL SCOTCH DOUBLES DIVISIONS: Players need not be from the same league **IF** both players are "Established" (as in they have a minimum of 200 games robustness at sign up)

- **1250U AND 1100U SCOTCH DOUBLES is NON-GENDER
- *1000U, 900U, and 800U SCOTCH DOUBLES are Jack & Jill.

ALL TEAM DIVISIONS: All team divisions are 3 person teams. Any gender combination. Players need not be from the same league **if ALL** team players are "established" (as in they have a minimum of 200 games robustness at sign up). The captain and any players under 200 robustness must be from the same league and any players from another league must have the 200-robustness minimum. If ALL players are from the same league, then there is no established robustness requirement.

SINGLES DIVISIONS

Players can only enter one singles event. There will be two classes of singles events, Elite and Divisional. All singles will be genderless meaning women and men will be in the same division/bracket.

- *Elite Singles Division: Sponsored by Chinook Winds Casino Resort who will add \$\$\$ to the prize fund. Players with a Fargo Rate of 600 and above must play in the Elite Singles. Any other players, regardless of their Fargo Rate, can enter this division.
- *Divisional Singles Divisions: All other players with a Fargo Rate of 599 and below will pay the same entry fee and after the entries are all in, the Divisional class will be divided by Fargo Ratings into divisions based on a sliding range.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

<u>Green Fees/Tournament Expenditures Fees:</u> - Are coupled with the entry fee for each division/event and are calculated based on statistics gathered at previous tournaments. Green Fees include all Tournament play, 2nd Chance Tournaments, Mini tournaments, any 'Fun Day' special events and practice. **TABLES WILL BE OPENED**

<u>Juniors</u>: If you are under the age of 21 you must declare yourself a junior on the entry form(s) and provide your birthdate. Failure to do so will result in disqualification and removal from the tournament venue. You must wear a provided wristband when in the tournament room.

2nd Chance Tournaments: There will be 2nd Chance Tournaments for all divisions. Single Elimination. Races and Entry Fees will be announced on site. All entrants must have been entered and not cashed in the original division.

Event Rules: governing rules of play are detailed in the latest edition of "Official Rules of CueSports International". Western BCA

Tournament Regulations also apply during this event. The Western BCA Tournament Regulations can be found on Western BCA's website (www.westernbca.org) and our social media pages. All participating players are responsible for knowing the rules. Shot Clock rules will be enforced if in fact slow play is determined. Other measures may be taken to speed up pace of play if necessary.

Saturday, October 11th, 2025, is Fun Day: Doors open at 8am. There will be the following Special Events: Women's Queen of the Hill, Fairmatched Senior's tournament, Open Singles, Banks and more...Please see fun day flyer for details. Tables will be open for all players entered in the Championships. WBCA players who are NOT signed up for any regional event can play in Minis and other events that day, but they MUST pay a \$15 green fee to the Western BCA Podium. The dress code will be relaxed on this day only.

<u>Dress Code:</u> The full text of the Dress Code that will be in force can be viewed at westernbca.org. The Dress Code will be in force October 12th – October 19th, 2025.

Medical Exemptions: Should a player require an exception to the Dress Code for medical reasons, the player must have a letter on official letterhead from the player's physician, give a copy to the President, Vice President or Tournament Registrar so they can make note of the Exception and keep a copy of this letter in his/her possession at all times, available for review by a referee or other tournament official if requested. If this is a PERMANENT condition, a physician's note stating this may be submitted once and will be kept on file. If you are hearing impaired and wear hearing aids, please get a letter from your doctor stating they are. However, any other devices (headphones, Bluetooth devices, etc.) in the ear are not allowed.

Mini's - OTHER than Fun Day

Paid Western BCA members that are NOT playing in any Regional Events for the week, may play in the MINI tournaments, BUT MUST pay \$10 per day for a Green Fee or \$50 for the week to be paid to the Western BCA Podium.
